In the name of God Amen. I Samuel Dishman of the County of Essex
and Saint Giles parish Being very sick and weak of body but of sound
sense and memory do ordain ^{and make} this my last Will in Testament revoking
and renouncing all other Will or Wills hitherto by me made first
I recommend my soul to almighty god hoping to have in him a joyful
resurrection, and my body to the Earth to be buried in a christian like
manner, at the discretion of my Executors hereafter mentioned
first I lend and bequeath unto my brother John Dishman all my
land

land to him and his heirs forever, but if he should die without heirs lawfully begotten of his body my land to return to my brother James Dishman and his heirs forever, I Item I give unto my brother John Dishman three negro men namely Henry William and Lewis to him and his heirs forever but that my brother John Dishman pay to my brother Jerimiah Dishman one hundred and sixty seven Dollars, and that my brother John Dishman pay to my brother William Dishman One hundred and Sixty Seven Dollars, and that my brother John Dishman pay to my brother James Dishman one hundred and Sixty Seven Dollars And that my brother John Dishman pay to my nephew Reuben Noel ninety nine Dollars, the whole amount being Six hundred Dollars to be paid to them or their heirs on or before the first day of April one thousand eight hundred and thirteen Legeseys which I wish to give them of my estate I Item I give unto my nease Sally Noel one feather bed and furniture, and two negro woman namely Sarah and Betta they and their increase to her and her heirs forever, and that shee have a house on my land as long as shee live single. I Item I give unto my sister Sarah Beazley two Cows and Earlings and one feather bed and furniture. I Item I give unto my nephew Reuben Noel one feather bed and furniture. I Item I give unto my brother John Dishman all the rest of my stock of cattle and hogs and all the remainder of my unmentioned estate, and that he my brother John Dishman

pay all my just debts lastly I do constitute and appoint my brother John Dish-
man executor of this my Last Will in Testament, And that he my brother John
Dishman qualify to this my last Will and administer and settle every thing
that appertaineth to my estate agreeable to this my last Will at his own
discretion without being bound to give Security as the law in these cases require
In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this Eighth Day
of April one thousand Eight hundred and Seven

At a Court held for Essex County at Ypsalhammock on
 the 15th Day of June 1807 This last Will and Testament
 of Samuel Dishman was brought into Court by John Dish-
 man, the executor therein named, and proved by the oaths
 of John Taylor and Andrew Remolds, two of the Witnesses to the same subscri-
 bed, and ordered to be recorded. And on the motion of the s^d John Dishman, he was
 permitted, and thereupon qualified as executor of the same by taking the oath
 prescribed by law, and without giving Bond & security, the Testator by his Will
 aforesaid requiring that no security should be taken; whereupon a Certificate
 was granted the s^d John Dishman in order to his obtaining probate of the
 s^d Testament in due form
