—Up to the 4th inst. the Comptroller's books show that 900 alcoholic and 1,100 malt liquor bell-punch registers had been disposed of throughout Texas, yielding a revenue to the State of \$500,000. Application for 400 more bell-punches were in hand to be filled. The law went into effect on the 1st day of October. 1744

—Jack Connors and Granville Dishman, two young men, had a quarrel at Bowling Green, Ky., on the night of the 5th, which terminated in Connors shooting Dishman through the heart, killing him instantly. The murderer was arrested.

—A man named Booth, who was charged with committing an indecent assault upon a young lady near Weatherford, Texas, was recently shot and killed by the lady's father, a Mr. Campbell. The latter was arrested.

—The ex-Mayor of Harrisonburg, Va., James P. Hyde, was shot on the public street of the town on the night of the 7th, by ex-Chief of Police James H. Kelly. He received two wounds, neither probably fatal.

—The 100th anniversary of the siege of Savannah and death of Sergeant Jasper, was commemorated in that city, on the 9th, in an imposing manner, in the presence of 15,000 or 20,000 people. Great enthusiasm prevailed. The volunteer soldiery of Charles-
