Transcript

Know all men by these presents that we William P. Scott and Geo. H. Dameron are held and firmly bound unto the Commonwealth of Virginia in the just and full sum of twenty thousand dollars lawful money of Virginia to be paid to the said Commonwealth, to the payment whereof will and truly to be made we bind ourselves and each of us, our and each of our heirs executors and administrators jointly and severally, firmly by these presents, sealed with our seals and dates this 16 day of January 1865.

The condition of the above obligation is such that if the above bound William P. Scott who has qualified as administrator of Powhatan Mitchell deceased, shall faithfully discharge the duties of his office as administrator aforesaid, then this obligation to be void, otherwise to remain in full force and virtue.
