It appearing to the Clerk of the Circuit Court of King
George County, Virginia, that Anna E. Dishman,
died on the 29th day of May 1929 at Trion, in the
County of King George, and that the said Anna
E. Dishman, at the time of her death had a mansion
house and known place of residence at Trion in the County,
of King George, and a writing signed by the said Anna
E. Dishman, but without subscribing witnesses
thereto, bearing date on the 1st day of March, 1927,
and purporting to be the true last will and testament
of the said Anna E. Dishman, deceased, having this
day been produced before the Clerk of the Circuit
Court of King George County, Virginia in his
said office, and proved according to law, by the
oaths of A. T. Wilkerson and J. N. Redman, two
disinterested witnesses who severally depose that
they were well acquainted with the hand writing
of the said Anna E. Dishman, deceased, and
that they verily believe the said writing, and the name

On the further motion of Ashby J. Frank, who made oath thereto as the law directs, and entered into a bond in the penalty of Four Hundred Dollars, conditioned according to law, with J. N. Redman, his surety therein who was

only justified, on oath as to his sufficiency) a certificate is granted the said Ashby F. Frank, for obtaining letters of administration with the will annexed on the estate of Anna E. Dishman, deceased, in due form, and the said bond being acknowledged by the obligors is ordered to be recorded.

On motion of Ashby F. Frank, the administrator with the will annexed, it is ordered that A. T. Millerson, Horace Mintz, Wilton Buscol, M. F. Parker & J. F. Perry, or any three of them, being first duly sworn for the purpose, do truly and justly appraise such of the goods & chattels of Anna E. Dishman, deceased, as may be produced before them, and return their appraisement under their hands as the law directs.
