

I William Dishman of the County of Washington State of Virginia; occupation farmer, Do make this my last will and Testament hereby revoking and making null and void all former wills by me at any time heretofore made.

1st I direct and request that my body be decently interred according to the rites and ceremonies of the Church to which I belong, and in a manner corresponding with my estate and situation in life.

2^dly, All my legal dues to be paid out of my estate.

3^dly, I will and bequeath to my son John all my real estate, after his death to his widow as long as she remains his widow, and then to his children.

4thly, I will and bequeath all my personal property to my son John with the following exceptions, to-wit: I will and bequeath to my grand daughter Susan E. Dishman the beds he is now occupying and my chest and whatever may be in it at my death and also a silver chest of drawers her. Signed and sealed this 30th day of April, 1870.
