IN MEMORIAM

J. C. Rhodes was born November 14, 1886; died March 14, 1919, age 33 years and four months. He professed faith in Christ at Centenary M. E. Church, near Marion, Va., at the age of 13. After going west he joined the Baptist Church, and lived a consistent christian life unto the end. He was married on December 21st 1905, to Miss Maud Grover. To this union was born one child who survives him. He is also survived by an aged father and mother, Rev. and Mrs. J. W. Rhoades, of near Marion, Va., one brother, William Rhoades, of Los Angeles, Cal., three sisters, Mrs. R. F. Prater, Marion, Va., Mrs. E. M. Pippin, of Knoxville, Tenn., and Mrs. J. C. Dishman, of Bristol, Va. He is the second member of the family to go out from home to come back no more, but the family knows where to meet him by the bright testimony he left behind. He called them around him and asked them to go with him on his journey; they asked him what journey, he answered "To Heaven, for I am going. My light is shining brightly. I see the way clear." He then asked his sisters, to send his far away brother a sweet good-bye for him, saying "He is the dearest brother on earth."

J. C. had been in declining health of the for two years. Trying to regain his health he went to a health resort, in Phoenix, Ariz., from which place he came home four weeks ago. Realizing his condition he made all preparations for his family, remembering also his father, mother, brother, sisters and nearest friends, who had done so much for him during his illness. He was very successful as a business man. And had just reached the point in life when he could have been of the greatest help to humanity financially and spiritually. It is indeed sad to think that such a young and useful life was cut off so soon. Funeral services were conducted by Rev. G. L. Shupe of the M. E. Church, in the presence of a large concourse of friends and sorrowing relatives. He was laid to rest in the Prater burying ground with impressive ceremonies by the Masonic Order last Sunday.

FUNERAL FOR MRS. RHOADES TOMORROW P. M.

Widow of Late Minister Died Yesterday at Marion; Daughter Lived in This City

Funeral will be held from the Prater home at Marion tomorrow afternoon at two o'clock for Mrs. J. W. Rhoades, widow of the late Rev. J. W. Rhoades and mother of Mrs. J. C. Dishman of this city, who died at the home of her daughter, Mrs. R. F. Prater, at Marion yesterday morning. Funeral services will be in charge of Rev. Johnson, pastor of the Methodist church at Marion, assisted by Rev. G. L. Shupe of Telford, Tenn.

The deceased had been in declining health for several months and during the past few weeks her condition had been critical. Although her death was not unexpected, her demise came as a shock to her many friends in Marion and vicinity and in Bristol. She was frequently a guest of her daughter here. She was 78 years, two months and four days of age at the time of her death.

She was born in Pulaski, County, Va., March 10, 1850. She was before her marriage Miss Lucinda Martin. She was married to J. W. Rhoades, also of Pulaski, on December 7, 1874. In this union were born six children, two boys and four girls. One son and one daughter preceded her to the grave.

Surviving are one son and three daughters as follows: W. M. Rhoades, of Los Angeles, Calif.; Mrs. E. M. Pippin, of Knoxville, Tenn.; Mrs. J. C. Dishman, Bristol, and Mrs. R. F. Prater, Marion, also two sisters, Mrs. A. J. Carter, and Mrs. Mary Rotenberg, of Radford, Va. She is survived by 13 grand-children and 18 great-grand-children.

Mrs. L. C. Martin Rhodes was born March 10, 1850, and departed this life May 14, 1928, age 78 years, 2 months and 4 days.

She was married to J. W. Rhoades December 7, 1870. He preceded her to their heavenly home eight years ago. To this union six children were born as follows: Mrs. Ila Prater, Marion, Va.; Mrs. J. C. Dishner, Bristol, Va.; Mrs. E. M. Pippin, Knoxville, Tenn.; Mr. William Rhoades, Los Angeles, California; Sallie Mae and Joseph Rhoades who departed this life some years ago, surviving are two sisters, Mrs. Rotenberg and Mrs. Carter of Radford, Va. Mrs. Rhoades, was converted at the age of sixteen and united with the Methodist Episcopal Church, to which she remained loyal and steadfast until God called her to the church Triumphant to join the blood washed throng, who are without spot and wrinkle, where neither pain nor death, nor crying, nor heartache are known; where Jesus and His saints reign in glory forever. While she is absent from us her consistent Christian life and the careful training of her children have put in motion a tidal wave of influence that will live on for years to come.

The funeral services were conducted at the home of her daughter, Mrs. Ila Prater, with whom she had been living for sometime.
