W. M. Grigsby Buried At Shiloh Friday Afternoon

Funeral services were held at Shiloh Baptist Church Monday for William M. Grigsby, 82, who passed away at his home near Dogue on June 13, after a lingering illness.

Born in this county in 1877, Mr. Grigsby was the son of the late William F. and Lucina Hudson Grigsby. An active member of Shiloh Baptist Church for 70 years, he was operator of a large farm near Dogue.
