



OBIT - HAGEY, WILLIAM ANDDERSON

HAGEY, William Anderson, 79, of Roanoke, died February 21, 1999, at the Veterans Administration Hospital, Salem, Va. He was predeceased by his parents, King Albert Hagey and Rosa Dulaney Hagey, also, brothers Harold Dulaney Hagey and Clarence Brandon Hagey. He graduated from Emory & Henry College, joined the Naval Reserve, graduated from the U.S. Merchant Marines at Kings Point, N.Y., and was commissioned an ensign in the Naval Reserve. He served in the Merchant Marines during World War II. An avid historian, antique collector, and genealogist, he co-authored, with his father, a 714-page book entitled "Hagey Families in America." His extensive genealogy research covering over 400 years, and most of his earthly possessions, have been given to the Virginia Historical Society in Richmond, Va. Surviving are brothers, King Albert Hagey, Jr. of Bristol, Tenn., Marvin Cameron Hagey of Kingsport, Tenn., David Dulaney Hagey of Mount Pleasant, Texas; and sister, Doris Hagey McGlashan of Santa Barbara, Calif.
