- Alchue, Casper, enlisted April 25th, 1861; died of disease contracted in camp, May 26, 1862.
- Alchue, Frank J., enlisted April 25th, 1861; discharged by order of the Secretary of War, in April, 1862.
- Andrews, Moses, enlisted April 25th, 1861; discharged by order of the Secretary of War in April, 1862.
- Anglo, A. Montrose, enlisted April 25th, 1861; transferred to Hospital Department, March 6th, 1862.
- Appleyard, John, enlisted April 25th, 1861; discharged by order of the Secretary of War in December, 1861.
- Allen, William A., enlisted in November, 1861; severely wounded (lost a leg), at

- of the war as a good soldier.
- Clayton, Henry, enlisted in 1863, con- script; missing at Gettysburg, July 2, 1863.
- Carr, Jesse, enlisted in May, 1863; served with his battery to the end of the war as a good soldier.
- Carver, Frank, enlisted in September, 1864; served with his battery to the end of the war as a good soldier.
- Cox, Benjamin, enlisted in January, 1863; served with his battery to the end of the war as a good soldier.
- Dansey, Thomas H., enlisted April 25, 1861; severely wounded at Suffolk, April 12, 1862; rejoined his battery and served to the end of the war as a gallant soldier.
- DeLarue, Hilare P., enlisted April 25, 1861; wounded at battle of Williamsburg, May 3, 1862; transferred to medical de- partment in the spring of 1863. A good soldier.
- DeLarue, Gus J., enlisted April 25, 1861; discharged by order of the Secretary of War in December, 1861.
- DeLarue, Joseph, enlisted April 25, 1861; transferred to the Purcell Battery in 1861.
- Dawson, R. E., enlisted April 25, 1861; wounded at Williamsburg, May 3, 1862; wounded at Plymouth, N. C., April 18, 1864; served to the end of the war. A gal- lant soldier.
- Doyle, George P., enlisted April 25, 1861; discharged by order of the Secretary of War in May, 1862.
- Doyle, Thomas, enlisted April 25, 1861; wounded at Petersburg in 1864; served with his battery to the end of the war as a good soldier.
- Duesberry, William W., enlisted April 25, 1861; missing at Malvern Hill, June, 1862.
- Duke, William O., enlisted April 25, 1861; discharged by order of the Secretary of War August 15, 1862.
- Dishman, L. L., enlisted in 1863, con- script; missing at Gettysburg, July 2, 1863.
- Day, Walter C., enlisted in March, 1864; served during the war with his battery as a good soldier.
- Dunn, James, enlisted in May, 1863; served to the end of the
