


This Indenture made this 19th day of March 1808 Between Archelus Mitchell of the one part & Thomas & Cubank of the other part, all of the County of Amherst Witnes-
 seth that the said Archelus Mitchell in order to secure the payment of a debt due to John & Richard S. Ellis of the County aforesaid, to wit, a bond of Fifty four pounds & one Shilling & sixpence lawful money of Virginia bearing date this day, and in consideration of the sum of one dollar to him in hand paid by the said Tho: & Cubank, at or before the en sealing & delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged me the said Archelus Mitchell hath granted bargained and sold, and by these presents doth grant bargain & sell unto the said Thomas & Cubank all my real and personal Estate to wit, four hundred acres of land lying in the aforesaid County on the Watters of the Cashaw Creek abraning James River, adjoining the lines of Thomas Jenkins, Roland Byrds and others, Moises, three Cows three feather Beds and furniture,

Pots, ovens and all other property herein not particularly mentioned and the issues and profits thereof, and of every part or parcel thereof, and also all the right^{and} title, interest trust property claim and demand, whatsoever both at law and inequity, of him the said Archelus Mitchell in, to, or out of the premises &c. To have and to hold the said premises &c to wit four hundred acres of Land as above written 2 horses, three cows Three feather beds & furniture, pots, ovens and all property not herein particularly mentioned, To be hereby granted with their and every of their appurtenances unto the said Tho^s N. Cubank his heirs Exors. admors and assigns forever: upon Trust Nevertheless that the said Tho^s N. Cubank shall as soon as he conveniently can after giving ten days previous notice by advertisement at some publick place nearest to the residence of the said Archelus Mitchell, Shall proceed to Sell to the highest bidder for the best price that can be had for one half in Twelve months from the date of this deed of trust and the other in Twelve months after, and out of the monies or proceeds of such Sale first pay all cost attending this deed of trust and reasonable charges, and debt herein mentioned and residue (if any) arising from such Sale to be paid to the said Archelus Mitchell his heirs Exors admors or assigns, or such person or persons as he by Writing under his hand shall appoint, & in default of such appointment, to his legal representative or representatives, In Testimony whereof We have hereunto set our hands & Seals the day & date above Written.
