

George *To all* **Know ye** that for divers good causes and considerations but more especially
for and in consideration of the sum of twenty five shillings of good and lawfull money for our use paid to our Receiver
Generall of our Revenue in this our Colony and Dominion of Virginia **we** have given granted and confirmed
and by these presents for us our Heires and Successors do give grant & confirm unto Thomas Stanton of Stafford
County our certain tract or parcel of land containing two hundred and fourteen acres lying and being in the
parish of Rappahannock River in St. Marys parish in Essex County and bounded as followeth, to wit, **beginning**
at a red and white oak by Rappahannock River side thence South Sixty five degrees West Eighty poles to a
hickory and two red oaks thence West north West three hundred and twenty poles to three red oaks thence
North Sixty four poles to two red oaks by the river side thence down the river to the beginning place **with**
all *To have hold* **To be held** *yielding and paying* **provid-**
ed *In witness* **witness** our trusty and well beloved Alexander Spotswood our Lt. Governour
at Williamsburgh under the seal of our said Colony the twenty second day of January one thousand
seven hundred and seventeen and in the fourth year of our Reiga — **A. Spotswood**
