Bowling Louis Mitchell, 81, died Thursday at 8:30 o'clock at his home at Peach, Amherst county, death resulting from a stroke of paralysis which he suffered several days previously. He enlisted in the Confederate army at the age of 18 years and was with Kirkpatrick's battery. After the war he returned home and lived there until his death. During the last fourteen years of his life Mr. Mitchell was blind. He was a member of Corner Stone Baptist church.
